STOPPED the adoption of dozens of modifications to the 2015 IRC, including the mandate of residential fire sprinklers and advocated for new S.C. specific wind and seismic maps.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: More than \$250 million annually.

DEFENDED small businesses and property rights across S.C. from further incursion from the E.P.A. and their expansion of jurisdiction of the "Waters of the U.S."

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: \$270,000 per permit.

PASSED a bill that reversed the S.C. Supreme Court's ruling on Crossman v. Harleysville Mutual and protects builders from faulty construction claims and provides stability with insurance coverage.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: \$100 million annually.

Advocated the adoption of a bill that addressed the significant increase in unemployment insurance premiums. The bill reduced the insurance premium to all employers by 25%.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: More than \$15 million annually.
