YOUR SC BUILDERS PAC AT WORK TOGETHER WE:

- ➔ **PASSED** the Home Occupancy bill, which provides tax relief on improved property for builders/developers that have new unoccupied homes.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: More than \$15 million yearly.
- ➔ **PASSED** a bill that reversed the S.C. Supreme Court's ruling on Crossman v. Harleysville Mutual and protects builders from faulty construction claims and provides stability with insurance coverage.
POTENTIAL SAVINGS: \$100 million annually.
